



College Credit Opportunity

High School of Business Students at Valley City State University

High School of Business students nationwide have the opportunity to earn up to nine (9) college credit from Valley City State University in Valley City, North Dakota. Credit is available for the following courses:

- ECON 202— Principles of Macroeconomics (3 credit hours)
- MGMT 270 — Business Ethics (3)
- BUSI 214— Business Communications (3)

In order to qualify for the college credit, you must:

- For ECON 202: receive a grade of 60 or above on the *High School of Business* Business Economics final exam
- For MGMT 270: receive a grade of 65 or above on the *High School of Business* Principles of Management final exam
- For BUSI 214: receive a grade of 70 or above on the *High School of Business* Business Strategies final exam
- Enroll at Valley City State University, and during the enrollment process indicate that you were a part of the *High School of Business* program. VCSU will prompt the student to provide test scores to the university.
